Enclosed for your convenience and review prior to the meetings is a schematic plan of the Trail Segment 3B-Phase 3 project area showing the trail's connection to the existing trail, planned alignment of the 8' wide macadam trail along Camp Hill Road, crosswalk locations, planned 6' macadam pathway through CHAC North that provides a connection to CHAC South, and a future connection to Virginia Drive (future Cross County Trail).

These meeting are advertised and open to the public. Meeting notice has been mailed to Camp Hill Road residents directly across from the project area, residents living on Elbow Lane and an adjacent Highland Ave. neighbor. Email notices have been issued to members of the Upper Dublin Township Board of Commissioners, the Upper Dublin Township Open Space Advisory Group and others with general interest about trails who have requested advance notice about public meetings.
