SKI & SNOWBOARD TRIP INFORMATION SHEET - 2010

1. **HOW TO REGISTER**

UDP&R will accept ski & snowboard trip registrations through Tuesday, February 9th at the Parks & Recreation Office located in the Township Building. Registration may be made in-person during scheduled business hours (9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday) or by drop-off any time of the day, evening or weekends using our convenient mailbox #59 or by the Online Store at www.upperdublin.net/store. Registration is confirmed only with full payment. **Fax and e-mail registrations are not accepted. If you have a number of questions or are skiing with UDP&R for the first time, we recommend you register in person during office hours.**

2. **AGE LIMITS**

All ages are invited on UDP&R ski trips. The only age stipulations we have are:

- children not yet 13 years of age must sign up with a friend or family member the same age or older **and** the two must ski together the whole day; and
- children 10 and under must sign up with a friend or family member aged 16 or older **and** the two must ski together the whole day.

3. **TRIP FEES**

In order to reserve a seat for a trip, the seat must be paid in full. You may sign up for one or more trips at any time. Non-Upper Dublin Township residents may register for our trips, but a \$5.00 per person per trip non-resident fee will be charged.

4. **CANCELLATION POLICIES**

In each case where **YOU** cancel your reservation, an eligible refund *minus a \$5.00 Administration Fee* will be credited to your ski trip account. The amount of the refund is determined as follows:

- Cancellations more than 5 business days before a trip = Refund of trip fees minus the \$5.00 Admin. Fee.
- Cancellations 1 to 5 business days before a trip* = Refund of trip fees minus bus money minus the \$5.00 Admin. Fee. **If a replacement is found for your seat, you'll receive a refund of your entire trip fee minus only the \$5.00 Admin. Fee.*
- No refund is issued for cancellations received after the close of business on the last business day prior to a trip (*i.e. Friday for a Monday trip; Thursday for a Friday trip; Friday for a Saturday trip*) or for "no shows" the day of a trip.

5. **REFUND CHECKS**

Refunds will be issued at the end of the ski season (after 3/10). If you paid by cash or check, your refund will be by check from the Department of Parks & Recreation and sent to your home. If you paid by credit card, your account will be credited at the end of the season. No refunds will be made in cash.

6. **SUBSTITUTIONS**

If you find it necessary to cancel your reservation, you may register a substitute in your place. This will result in a \$5.00 Administrative Fee being subtracted from your refund **if** UDP&R is involved in the financial transaction. If the two parties handle the transaction privately, and there is to be no refund made by UDP&R, then there is no Administrative Fee assessed against your account.

If the substitute is sent the day of the trip with no pre-arrangements made with UDP&R, he/she **must** have a **Hold Harmless Agreement** on file -or- a letter of permission from a parent or guardian presented to UDP&R at skier check-in.

7. **WAIT LIST**

Each bus can hold a max. of either 47 or 55 passengers. A **Wait List** of pre-paid skiers who are closed out of the first bus will be formed. In order to take a second bus for any given trip, at least 35 pre-paid skiers must be on the Wait List.

To the extent possible, UDP&R will call wait listed skiers in order of registration to fill canceled seats on the first bus. You may also call UDP&R starting three business days before the trip to inquire if the additional bus is confirmed and a seat has been made available for you. Wait Listed skiers may be called any time up until 9:00 pm the night before a trip. If you are not called, your money will be transferred to another trip (no Administrative Fee assessed) or refunded in full at the end of the season, **your choice**.

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8. **FIRST TIME SKIERS / SNOWBOARDERS**

UDP&R considers it **ESSENTIAL and IN THE BEST INTEREST** of first time skiers/snowboarders that each is familiar with the basics of the sports – e.g., stopping, turning, control, getting up after a fall, staying out of the way of others, getting on/off lifts, stepping in and out of equipment. This can be achieved with a FIRST DAY ON SKIS/SNOWBOARD package option (if offered; if not: a BEGINNER LESSON).

Please stress to your child the importance of knowing the mountain and the areas/slopes that new and novice skiers/boarders should avoid – even if their friends tell them it will be “no problem.” Knowing basic skills and use of common sense will help avoid a visit to or day resting in the First Aid Station – which our experience shows can be occur as early as 9am!

9. **RENTALS**

Rental shops at ski mountains are often slow, causing skiers and snowboarders to lose valuable time on the mountain...sometimes more than an hour...and sometimes making skiers and snowboarders miss a prepaid, important lesson! **AGAIN IN '10: Rentals are offered. There is a separate rental sheet for anyone who is renting at the mountains. This sheet must be filled out and signed by both the participant and parent/guardian (if under 18 years of age) prior to the day of the trip. Rental forms are available on line at www.upperdublin.net.** If you wish to avoid the long lines in any of the ski rental shops, rent equipment ahead of time and bring it on the bus.

You will appreciate the fit and feel of rentals obtained from a local rental shop. Get fitted and on the reservation list EARLY! Compare prices: You may even want to rent for the season.

Your snowboards, skis, poles and/or boots should be well marked with your last name on masking tape or adhesive tape. Carry a cable lock with you and know the combination. To make carrying equipment easier, invest in ski and bootstraps or an all-in-one ski tote -- also well marked with your last name.

10. **SNOW STORMS/SCHOOL SNOW MAKEUP DAYS**

In the unfortunate event that UDP&R must cancel a ski trip at the last minute due to unsafe driving conditions or resort shut-down, the cancellation notice will be aired over **KYW radio (1060 AM), a message in the UDP&R office at 215-643-1600 ext. 3443 and, if possible, on cable channel 22. PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE UPPER DUBLIN POLICE or a group leader.**

FULL REFUNDS will be issued to those on the bus list in these cases at the end of the ski season. Only the \$5.00 Administrative Fee will be deducted from refunds for anyone who withdrew from the trip before it was canceled by UDP&R.

11. **HOLD HARMLESS FORM**

The Township requires that a **signed Hold Harmless form** (permission slip) be on file for every skier/snowboarder who participates in the program. Hold Harmless forms are available at the Parks & Recreation Office. *One form is good for the entire season. A new form is required each season.*

*This form must be signed by the skier's/boarder's parent or guardian,
unless the skier/boarder is at least 18 yrs. of age.*

12. **INSURANCE & ACCIDENTS**

All skiers must be covered by a personal or family medical plan, including hospitalization. Should an accident occur, every attempt will be made by the group leaders to notify the parents from the mountain.

If the injury precludes the skier's/boarder's ability to be transported home by bus, the parents will be required to transport their child and a group leader home from the mountain or resort area hospital.

In all cases involving medical attention, group leaders will follow the advice of the trained medical staff provided by the mountain.

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13. **GROUP LEADERS**

At least two adult group leaders will accompany each ski bus. All group leaders are experienced skiers and tour leaders.

14. **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- a. Lockers are available for rent at the mountain. Participants are responsible for their own belongings and the cost of the locker. Do not place anything of value in the bins that are provided at no cost.
- b. Food can be brought from home or purchased at the mountain. It is suggested that participants bring lunch as well as morning and afternoon snacks and/or beverages. Food may be purchased at the mountain, but it is rather costly.
- c. Personal CD, tape and DVD players with head phones may be brought with you. It is suggested that these items be left on the bus. The bus will be locked while we are at the mountain.
- d. Participants should wear street shoes and bring a change of clothing. These items can be left on the bus or taken into the lodge and kept in a locker.
- e. The bus(es) usually remain at the mountain for the entire day, but they will not be open or available to participants until ½ hour before departure.
- f. We show G, PG, or PG-13 videos on the ride home.
- g. Our bus(es) are no smoking buses and alcohol is not permitted on any UDP&R trip.
