RECYCLEBANK

Residents earn reward points for recycling which can be redeemed for valuable coupons or donated to a good cause. All recyclable materials are put in the **BLUE** cart.



NEW! # 1 to # 7 Plastics! We now recycle plastics # 1- #7. Please NO Styrofoam peanuts, PVC or plastic bags.

Acceptable recycling materials include:

Glass bottles and jars (all colors)

Aluminum, and Bi-Metal Cans

Paper and Cardboard*

*** PAPER: Newspapers, office paper, magazines, catalogues, junk mail, single layered and corrugated cardboard.**

(NO Textbooks or Phonebooks, please)

LARGER CARDBOARD boxes must be flattened, bundled and scheduled for pick up by calling the receptionist before noon on Tuesday for a Wednesday pick up.

As a courtesy to our crews and to keep your RecycleBank cart clean, please rinse out all cans, bottles and jars. For repair, replacement or to order a different size RecycleBank cart, or to check on earned rewards points, please call 1-888-727-2978 or visit www.recyclebank.com.



TRASH

Household trash is collected once each week. Place your **BROWN** cart out by the curb the **NIGHT BEFORE** your collection day. Place cart at least four feet away from obstructions to accommodate the automated trash truck. Trash outside the cart will not be picked up. **Please retrieve all carts after they have been serviced.**

Extra Trash Pick Up

*Extra bags of trash will be picked up on your regular trash day during the weeks of December 24th, & December 31st, 2012. These collections do not include bulk items. See the Township website for more details.

* Additional trash collection is also available on Wednesdays. A \$10 fee is charged to empty the brown cart. Call the receptionist to schedule pick up and arrange for payment.

BULK TRASH PICK UP (Wednesdays only)

All appliances, furniture, carpet, and other "bulk" items must be scheduled with the Township Receptionist for bulk trash pick-up by Noon on Tuesday. Call (215) 643-1600, extension "0", M-F, 8AM to 5PM for guidelines, restrictions, fees and scheduling information. Orders may also be placed using the **ONLINE STORE** on the Township website.

Storm Water Management

Residents are asked to reduce runoff pollution by doing the following:

- © Keep pesticides, oil, trash and other pollutants off streets and out of storm drains.
- © Divert roof water to lawns and gardens where it can safely soak in.
- © Clean up pet waste and dispose of properly in pet waste systems or in regular trash.

Christmas Tree Collection 2013

Trees will be collected curbside North of Susquehanna Road on

Wednesday, January 9th. South of Susquehanna Road will be collected on Wednesday, January 16th. Any remaining trees will be collected on Wednesday, January 30, 2013.

Please do not place your tree in a plastic bag. All decorations must be removed. Trees are composted by the Township.

Yard Waste



Yard waste, brush and tree branches will be collected curbside once a week during the Yard Waste Program. **Yard waste collection**

will begin the week of March 5th and end the week of December 17th, 2012. Grass clippings and leaves must be placed in containers or biodegradable paper bags. Please **DO NOT** use your BROWN TOTER for Yard Waste. **Please do not use plastic bags.** All yard waste is composted into a high grade mulch product. Yard waste must be placed at curbside the **night before** your scheduled collection day. **Brush and tree limbs must be tied with twine into bundles not to exceed 5' in length and weigh no more than 50 lbs. Branches with a diameter greater than 5" will not be taken. Please limit yard waste to a maximum of nine (9) containers, paper bags, and/or bundles. NO WOOD CHIPS.**

Leaf Collection 2012

Township vacuum collection of leaves requires leaves to be raked curbside, *not in the street*, in accordance with ordinance #1081. Weather conditions may severely affect adherence to the schedule below. Crews will begin collection in the following areas during the WEEKS of:

NEW COLLECTION DATES!

Please note: Houses on both sides of Fort Washington Avenue are collected in AREA #3. Area #1 and #2 will BOTH be collected the week of December 10th.

Do not place your leaves at the curb more than 7 days before your scheduled week of pick-up. Utilize the yard waste program to dispose of your leaves until the leaf collection program begins and in between scheduled collections. Please do not mix sticks, branches or other yard waste with your leaves at the curb. **Branches, rocks and other debris cause major damage to the leaf vacuum machines. Please place only LEAVES at the curb for vacuum collection.**

Camp Hill Road Compost Site Facility

Our facility is located at 1128 Camp Hill Road next to Mondauk Manor Park where mulch is made available to residents at no charge. Call the Public Works Department for operating hours. Self-service areas are located in the lower parking area of Mondauk Manor Park and across from the Maple Glen Elementary School off of Fort Washington Avenue. Mulch is made available dawn to dusk, 7 days a week, while supplies last.



Snow Emergencies

Off-Street Parking

To assist snow and ice removal, the Upper Dublin Police Department requests that during snow emergencies all residents use off-street parking for vehicles. **Residents without off-street parking should follow this schedule:** on even numbered days parking is permitted on the side of the street with even numbered houses; on odd numbered days parking is permitted on the side of the street with odd numbered houses. **Ordinance #656 will be strictly enforced!**

Snow Removal

Residents are reminded that sidewalks must be cleared of snow and ice within 24 hours of the end of a winter storm in accordance with Township Code. **It is illegal to shovel, plow or blow snow onto a street in accordance with Ordinance #1062. Please use proper snow etiquette by removing all trash carts and other obstacles in the street.**

To reduce the possibility of damage to your mailbox by the snowplow, check with the Public Works Department to be sure that your mailbox is installed at the proper height and set back from the street.

Remember to shovel snow to the right side of your driveway, facing the road. This will help to reduce the amount of snow pushed back into your driveway during plowing.

PennDOT is responsible for snow and ice control as well as road repairs on all State Roads. Call 610-275-2368 to report hazardous conditions on STATE roads.

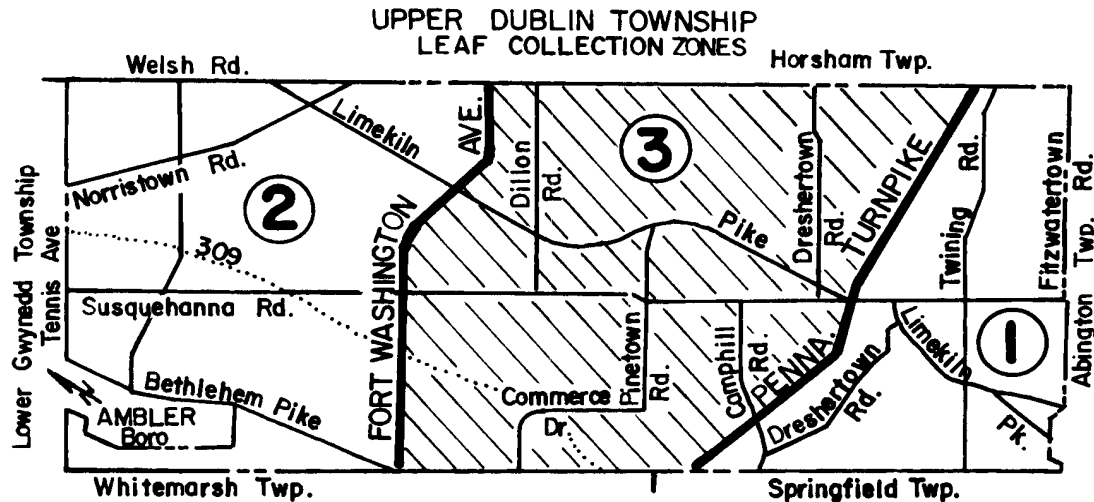
