Wheeled Yard Waste Cart

Collection Program

Your neighborhood has been selected to participate in the expansion of our yard waste collection program. This program utilizes wheeled carts that are specially designed for fully automated and semi-automated collection vehicles.

Please use your new cart on your next scheduled yard waste collection day. To ensure that this program runs as efficiently as possible, we ask that you make this your primary container for your yard waste.

All excess yard waste should be placed in cans, biodegradable paper bags or tied into bundles with twine and placed near your new cart. Please limit your yard waste to nine (9) bags, cans or bundles total per week.

Do not use your BROWN refuse cart (issued by the township) for yard waste.



Wheeled Yard Waste Cart Features:

- 95-Gallon Capacity
- Provides a uniform look throughout your neighborhood.
- Easy to wheel to and from the street.
- Creates a cleaner environment for everyone.
- Stability in high winds – if your cart should tip over, it will not roll away.
- Reduces the possibility of injuries to our crews.
- Smooth design of the cart allows for yard waste to slide out and for easy cleaning.
- 10-year manufacturer's warranty.

PLEASE REMEMBER THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- Place your cart out at the curb the *NIGHT BEFORE* your scheduled collection day.
- The Yard Waste Collection Program runs from the 1st FULL week of March until the end of the 3rd FULL week in December.
- Place ONLY YARD WASTE material in your cart, not trash.
- Your yard waste is processed into usable mulch, which is free and available at several self-service locations in the township. Check the website for locations and more info.
- Place your cart so that the wheels abut against the curb (see picture on left). If you do not have curbing on your street, place your cart so that the front of your cart is even with the grass line (see picture on front of brochure).
- Keep the lid closed to prevent the collection of rainwater.
- Notify the Public Works Department if your cart is damaged.

PLEASE.....

- DO NOT place plastic flower pots, planters, household trash, lumber, fencing or wood posts in your cart.
- DO NOT place stumps, logs, root balls, wood chips, dirt, sod, rocks or branches that exceed 4 foot in length or 4 inches thick in your cart.
- DO NOT write or paint on the exterior of your cart (instead, put your address on the inside of the lid).
- DO NOT overfill cart or pack cart too tightly.
- DO NOT remove the cart from your property or lend it out.
- DO NOT store or place your cart near any source of excessive heat.
- DO NOT set your cart close to any obstructions such as mailboxes, fire hydrants, utility poles, parked cars or other trash cans.
