The Township provides the street lighting to light public ways for motorist and pedestrian safety, not to provide private property lighting.

**Check off the following removal criteria that apply (if you know the answer):**

- \_\_\_\_\_ A mid-light street light, not specifically covering an intersection,
- \_\_\_\_\_ Located on a straight- way of roadway, not on curve
- \_\_\_\_\_ Not covering areas with significant on-street parking

- \_\_\_\_\_ Not at the end of Cul-de-sac

Lights proposed for removal would be posted as such and turned off without having the physical structure removed for 30 days. Without significant complaint or challenge to the removal, it would then be scheduled for removal. The costs go down only if the light is removed.

**Street lights that would operate with a programmable photocell timer:**

- Programmable photocell timers would be installed on fixtures at mid-block locations where long blocks exist or along long uninterrupted street segments where the elimination of all street lighting would be inappropriate.
- One proposed timing for these lights is off at night after 2am.
- This type of timing saves energy, but does not result in a cost reduction under the current PECO tariff structure.
