

LEAF COLLECTION

Leaves are required to be raked curbside - **not in the street** - before each collection week begins.

Please do not park on the street during your collection week.

Leaves will **not** be collected if:

- they are in the street
- branches, sticks, or rocks are mixed in
- cars are parked on or near leaves

Weather permitting, leaf collections will take place during the following weeks:

CAMPBILL ROAD COMPOST SITE

1128 Camphill Road · M-F 7AM to 2PM*

Residents may drop off yard waste at the compost site during normal operating hours. The hours of operation are subject to change without notice. Please call before arriving to verify that the site is open. Proof of residency is required.

*January & February Hours: 12PM-2PM

As part of the automated yard waste collection program, the Compost Site will be open several Saturdays throughout the year for residents to drop off yard waste or pick up mulch. A loader will be available to load mulch. See the Township website for dates.

Self-service areas to pick up mulch are located in the lower parking area of MonDaug Bark Park and across from Maple Glen Elementary School. **Mulch is available at no charge.** No yard waste drop off is available at either self-service mulch site.

SNOW

Snow Emergencies

During snow emergencies, all residents should use off-street parking whenever possible. Residents without off-street parking should follow the alternate-side parking schedule:

-**Even-numbered days:** Park on the side of the street with even-numbered houses.

-**Odd-numbered days:** Park on the side of the street with odd-numbered houses.

Ordinance #656 is strictly enforced. For Snow Emergency Routes within Upper Dublin Township, please visit the Township website.

Snow Removal

Sidewalks must be cleared of snow and ice within 24 hours of the end of a winter storm, in accordance with Township Code. It is illegal to shovel, plow, or blow snow onto the street under Ordinance #1062. Please remove all trash and recycling carts, along with any other obstacles, from the street so plows can operate safely.

To reduce the possibility of damage to your mailbox during snowplowing, check with the Public Works Department to ensure your mailbox is installed at the proper height and is 12 inches from the face of the curb.

PennDOT

PennDOT is responsible for snow and ice control on Morris Road and the 309 Expressway. PennDOT also handles all road repairs on state roads.

-To report hazardous conditions on state roads, call 610-275-2368.

-To report potholes, call 1-800-FIX-ROAD.

Pennsylvania Turnpike

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission is responsible for snow and ice control, as well as all road repairs, on the Turnpike. To report hazardous driving conditions, call 1-800-331-3414.

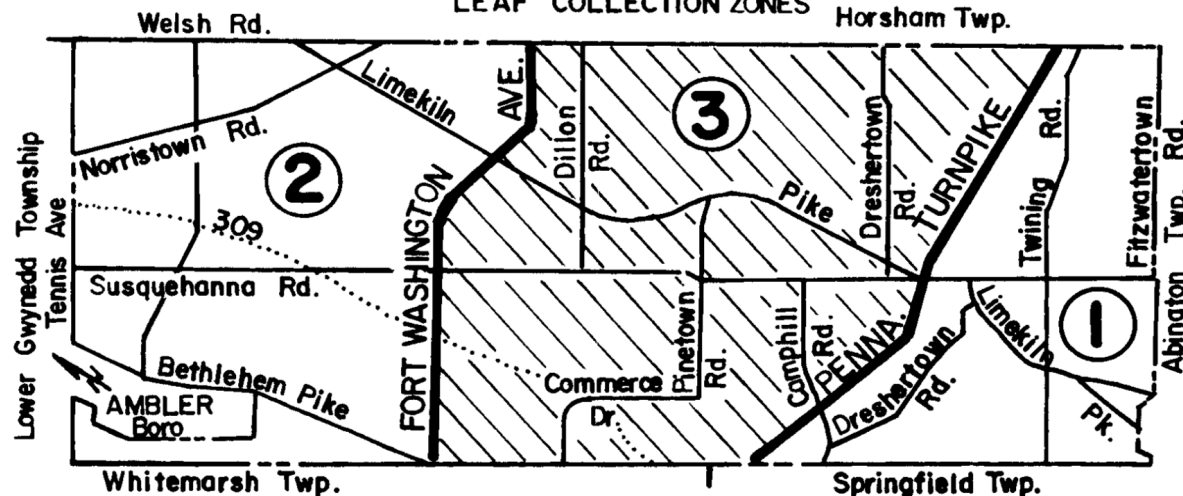

RECYCLING

The following may be placed in your blue recycling cart:

- #1 - #7 plastic bottles and containers
- Glass bottles and jars (all colors)
- Aluminum and bi-metal cans and lids
- Cartons: milk, juice, and broth
- Paper: newspaper, junk mail and flattened, non-corrugated cardboard

Do not put items in plastic bags.
Do not overload your cart.
Please rinse all food containers.

DO NOT recycle the following: Styrofoam™, soiled pizza boxes, paper plates, shredded paper, scrap metal, wire, food waste, clothing, hangers, loose caps, coffee/soda cups, diapers, tissues, trash, toys, PVC plastics, hoses, bubble wrap, or plastic bags/film..

Household trash is collected once each week. Place your brown cart at the curb the night before your collection day. Carts must be placed one foot (1') apart from each other and three feet (3') away from mailboxes, cars, trees, and other obstructions. Trash outside of the cart will not be collected. Please remove your carts from the curb within 24 hours of collection.

Holiday Trash Pickup

Up to five (5) extra bags of trash will be collected on your regular trash day during the weeks of December 14th, 21st, and 28th, 2026. This does not include bulk items.

Bulk Trash Pickup

Additional trash collections (brown cart) and collection of bulk items—such as appliances, furniture, and carpeting—must be scheduled and paid for by 12PM on Tuesdays for Wednesday pickup. Submit a bulk collection request at upperdublin.net/bulk or call 215-643-1600 ext. 0.

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTIONS

Live Christmas trees will be collected curbside on your first three regular trash collection days in 2027, beginning the week of January 4th. Please do not place your tree in a plastic bag. All decorations must be removed. Trees are composted by the Township.

YARD WASTE

Yard waste collection will begin the week of March 2, 2026 and end the week of November 16, 2026.

The green cart is for yard waste only. Do not place trash or recyclables in this cart; they will not be collected. **Do not use plastic bags.** All yard waste is composted into mulch, which is made available to residents free of charge.

For area A: Brush and tree limbs placed outside of your cart must be tied with twine into bundles not exceeding four feet (4') in length and weighing no more than 50 pounds. Branches with a diameter greater than six inches (6") will not be collected. Yard waste is limited to a maximum of nine (9) total containers, paper bags, and/or bundles.

Automated Yard Waste

Automated yard waste collection is provided in Areas B, C, and D (with Area A to be included at a later date).
