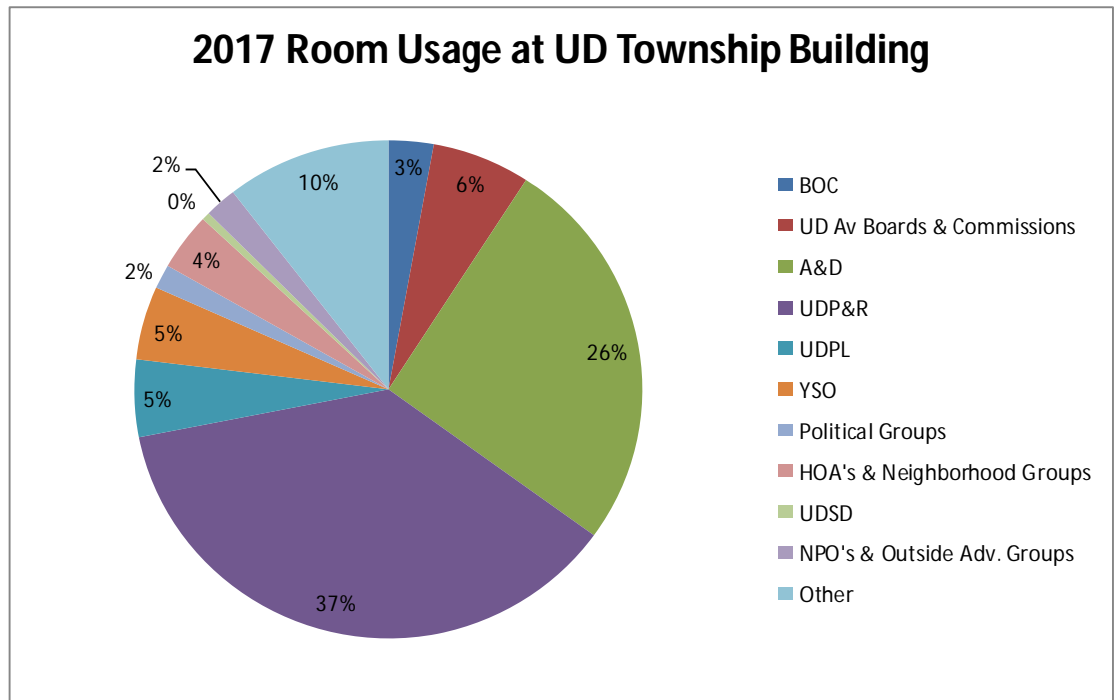


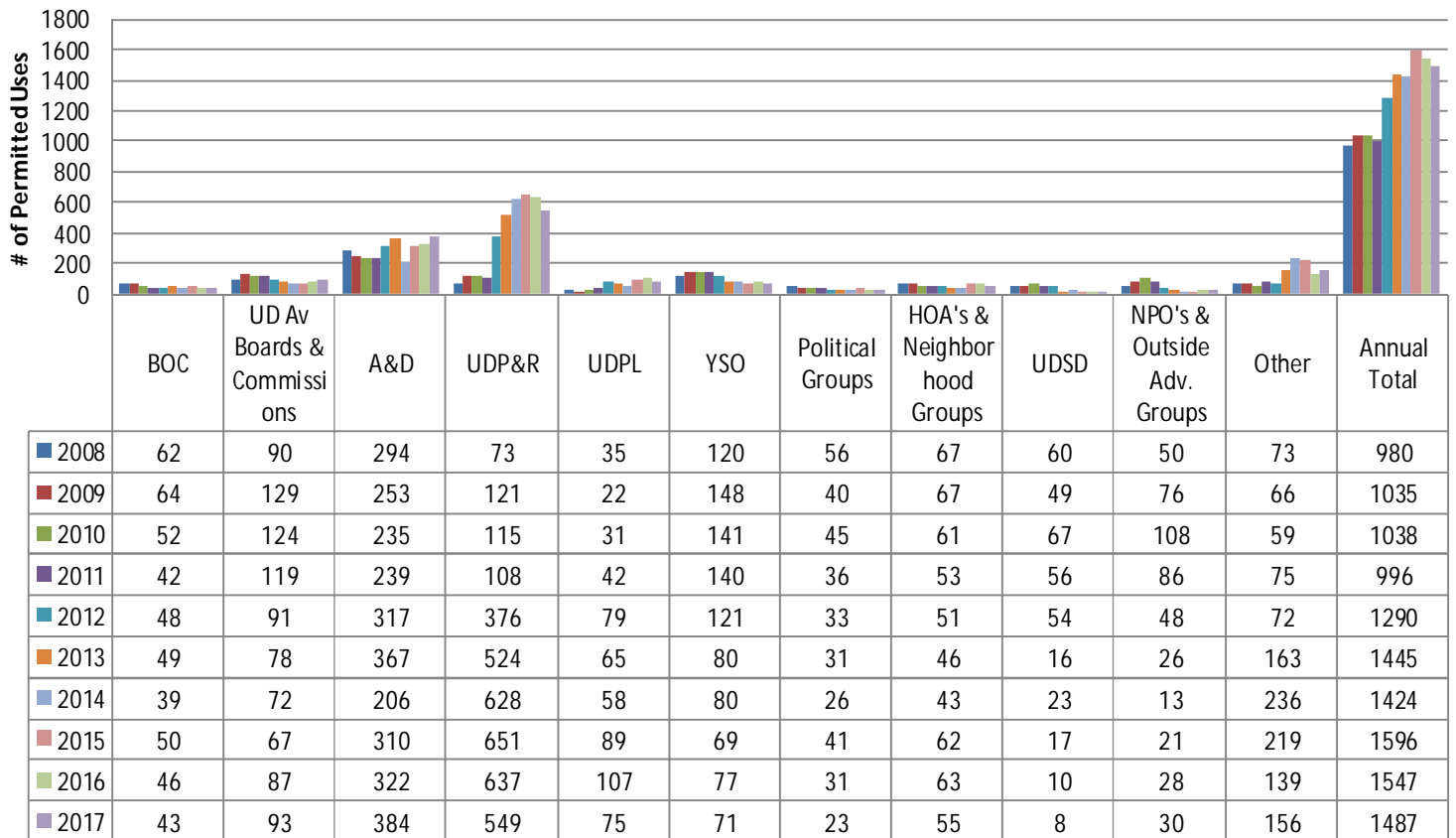
Upper Dublin Township Building Meeting Room Usage

The Upper Dublin Parks & Recreation Department (UDP&R) is responsible for the scheduling, setting up/breaking down and management of the Township Building's meeting spaces, which includes the Community Rooms (total of 3,385 ft² - ability to divide into 3 equal-sized rooms), Main Meeting Room (total of 1,900 ft² - ability to divide into 2 rooms) and Conference Room (accommodates 12 attendees). The data does not include uses that have been relocated to the UD Library or the FW Firehouse.

The primary reason for the dramatic increase in room usage from 2011 to 2012 was a result of two other Township facilities being vacated. UDP&R programs were relocated to the Township Building at this time. Since 2012, demand for meeting space at the Township Building has continued to increase and has plateaued because there is no space available during high demand days/times - Mon. to Thurs. evenings. Demand has limited the growth for Township services (UDP&R and UDPL). Other community and private group requests have also been turned down because of a lack of availability.
