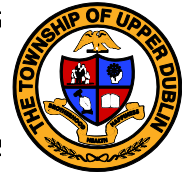

Upper Dublin Township Receives \$1 Million Grant for New Library

(Upper Dublin Township, PA – August 1, 2019) Governor Tom Wolf’s office just announced today that Upper Dublin Township was among the recipients for the latest round of Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program funding for the new library project. The award amount is \$1 million. A highly competitive grant, this grant brings new, unexpected funding to the project.

This award is the second grant Upper Dublin Township has received to support the repurposing of the 520 Virginia Drive property as a new library. The first was a \$750,000 Keystone grant, announced in September 2018, which is funded through the Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation Fund. This brings a total of \$1,750,000 so far to the project from state grants.

Deepest thanks to all four of our local legislators: Senator Vincent Hughes and Representatives Thomas Murt, Ben Sanchez and Todd Stephens. The Township is grateful for their continued support and vision for this innovative project.

The Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP) is a Commonwealth grant program administered by the Office of the Budget for the acquisition and construction of regional economic, cultural, civic, recreational, and historical improvement projects.
