- DATE & TIME: Sunday, September 15, 2019 | Parade kicks-off at 1:00 pm
- THEME: Celebrate Upper Dublin!
Note: Decorations do not need to be UD related. We are celebrating the people, places, organizations and businesses that make Upper Dublin a great place to live! It's all about YOU!
- ROUTE: Parade entries check in at Temple University Ambler (580 Meetinghouse Rd., Ambler, PA 19002)
BEGINS at the intersection Meetinghouse Rd./Woods Dr. -> Fort Washington Ave. -> Fort Washington Elementary School
- Be advised that a portion of the parade route is uphill at a slight incline.
 - Entries must be available to participate in the entire parade.
 - Participants must arrange for a drop-off at the staging area and pick-up at the ending point, as necessary.
- REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Forms must be received by Friday, September 6, 2019 at 5:00 pm
- Late entries may be accepted, if space allows.
 - All registering entries must send a hold harmless form (at the end of the registration packet – also found on the Tricentennial webpage (udt300.com))

- ENTRY GUIDELINES: Entries must follow the intent of *Celebrate Upper Dublin!*
We encourage participation by all community groups, school clubs, business owners, sports teams/organizations, Scouts, musical groups, historical societies, performers/entertainers, neighborhood groups, veterans' organizations, antique and classic car owners, and clubs.
- All parade entries must be family-friendly.
 - Entries may walk, ride or be on "floats."
 - Entries must supply all of their own materials, supplies, decorations, equipment and required transportation.
 - Parade entries will not be judged. There are no prizes or awards.
 - No political groups are permitted to campaign.
- Note: Parade Organizers reserve the right to refuse or remove entry to any group not adhering to Parade Guidelines or violating the intent of the event.*
- SIGNS/BANNERS: Each entry is required to have a sign identifying their group or organization. Feel free to creatively name your float or group.
- MUSIC: Indicate on the registration form if your entry will include music of any kind (live or recorded).
- All music must be family-friendly.
 - If using recorded music, each entry is required to play its own music from its own speakers.
- SAFETY: For the safety of parade spectators, parade participants:
- may carefully toss wrapped candy and/or hand out small items.
 - under the age of 18 must be accompanied by adults at a ratio of 15:1.
 - must wear helmets and safety gear if riding bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller blades, motorcycles, go carts, or other wheeled vehicle. This is required for all ages.
 - may not distribute water bottles or large, bulky items.
 - may not invite spectators to approach a moving vehicle/parade entry during the parade.
 - may not have water guns that are used to spray each other or spectators.
 - are not permitted to collect canned goods, non-perishables or money along the route.

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NOTES:

- Complete one form for each registering group. Each form applies to every member of the registering/participating group. The contact person (must be over eighteen [18] years of age) for the group should sign and date the bottom of the form.
- Registrations are accepted only with this signed hold harmless form.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT:

Each Tricentennial Parade participant in this registering/participating group and/or (if under the age of eighteen) his/her/their guardian, in consideration for the Township of Upper Dublin does hereby:

- agree to assume all risks and responsibilities of possible damage or injury involved through participation in said activity. I, the contact person for the registering group, understand I am to furnish my own insurance in case of injury.
- request permission to participate in the activity with the full knowledge that the said activity could result in damage or injury to him/her/them.
- agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Township, its departments and agents from liability for personal injury or property damage resulting from participation in said activity.
- waive the right to dispute all proper charges once he/she/they have registered and/or participated in the Tricentennial Parade.
- agree to allow Upper Dublin Township to use any photos taken at an activity for future Township publications.
