

2021 Upper Dublin Parks & Recreation Program & Summer Camp FAQ's

Is UDP&R offering in-person programs?

Where appropriate, in-person programs will begin February 1st. We will continue to closely monitor state and federal guidelines provided to make program decisions and modifications as needed. As the COVID-19 situation is rapidly changing, consider subscribing to the UDP&R eNews and follow UDP&R on Facebook in order to stay up-to-date on all program and event decisions.

What is the status of summer camps and when will those decisions be made?

More information about UDP&R summer camps will be available in March. Final decisions about camp dates, descriptions and/or modifications (ex. camp going virtual) could be made by Recreation Division staff as late as 1 week prior to the start of a camp, but we hope to follow what is originally advertised during registration. We will continue to closely monitor guidelines provided by the state and federal government and make camp decisions and modifications as needed. As the COVID-19 situation is rapidly changing, consider subscribing to the UDP&R eNews and follow UDP&R on Facebook in order to stay up-to-date on all program and event decisions.

Where will the summer camp(s) be held?

No decisions on in-person camp locations have been made at this time, but will be communicated to those interested in registering as those decisions are made. We will continue to closely monitor state and federal guidelines provided to make camp decisions and modifications as needed. How do I register for the summer camp(s)?

That will depend on the camp you are interested in:

Registration for summer camps will begin in April, 2021. Please note that both virtual and in person camps may be added throughout the spring/summer. To remain up-to-date on the camps being offered, consider subscribing to the UDP&R eNews and follow UDP&R on Facebook.

Residency restrictions may be re-evaluated throughout the summer.

What about KidZone and/or X-Zone?

We will continue to closely monitor guidelines provided by the state and federal government to make camp decisions and modifications as needed. We anticipate we will have summer camp options available in 2021. We are working to finalize plans in March.

If virtual or modified camps are offered, how much will it cost?

Camp fees are currently being developed and will be announced as soon as details are finalized.

What if my child doesn't like the new camp(s)?

UDP&R's unhappy camper policy would still apply.

My grandchildren are staying with me for the summer, can I register them?

Residency is based on the school district in which the child attends.
